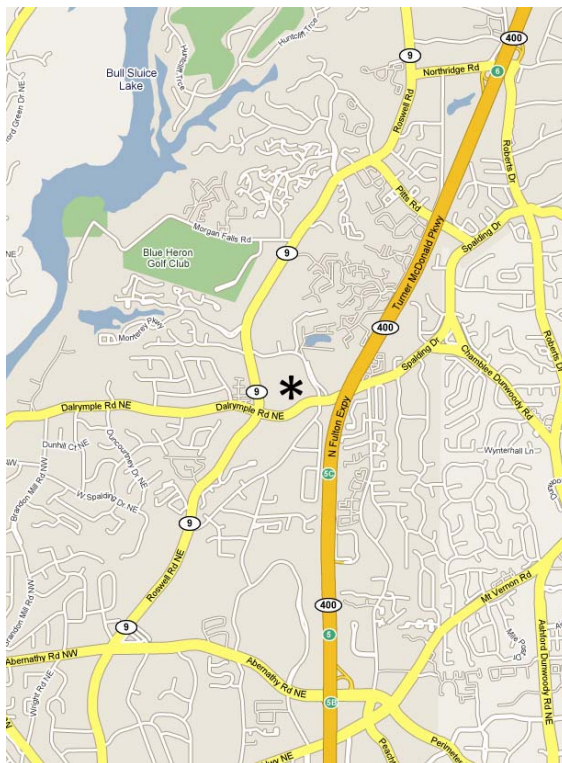

Getting to The Auditions

Auditions are held at North Springs High School in Sandy Springs. Follow the directions below.

From Atlanta: Take GA 400 North to Exit 5B, onto Abernathy Rd (Sandy Springs). Go 1.1 miles on Abernathy Rd. Turn right onto Roswell Rd. Turn right at second light onto Dalrymple Rd. North Springs High School is on the left.

From Alpharetta: Take GA 400 South to Exit 6, Northridge. Turn left at end of ramp and continue to Roswell Rd. Turn left and travel about 1.5 miles. Turn left onto Dalrymple Rd. at light. School is on left.

Each instrument is to prepare two contrasting pieces. You may prepare any two pieces of your choosing including repertoire, hymns, and scales.

Each piece is not to exceed 2 minutes 30 seconds in length.

In addition to two prepared pieces, you may be asked to sight read one or more short pieces.
